

## **Annual Palouse Pride March**

"There is no radical gay agenda," said organizer Susan Rydeen. "It is not a political movement." It's just Palouse Pride '05, a day for a parade and a festival, led by the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgendered and questioning community, their friends and family.

Many feel hate crimes and more subtle forms of oppression against the LGBTQ community reflect a need for a showing of community support.

During the spring of 2002, three members of the UI Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity stole and burned a flag of the UI Gay Straight Alliance. While arrests were made and those responsible were prosecuted, being targeted is something that can have an "impact for life," said Assistant Police Chief David Duke.
